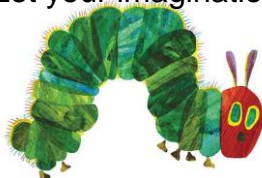
Potting with poetry

Do plants really like it if you talk to them? This is what a month long study by the Royal Horticultural Society set out to answer when recordings of readings from Shakespeare's A Midsummer's Night Dream and Darwin's On the Origin of Species were played to tomato plants through MP3 players attached to their pots. The tomato plants grew up to 2 inches taller if they were read to!

So Cherry Tree is inviting all young people to pot their own plant at the nursery and to bring along a passage from their favourite story or a poem to read to it. There will also be some books on the day to delve into. Then write up and decorate your choice of poem or passage for display for all to enjoy.
